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Procedures are based on the median number of procedures reported by trainees in the deanery when compared against other deaneries. Criteria are ranked in quintiles from 1-Excellent to 5-Very bad. Overall/procedural/training environment rankings are a summative measure of the detailed sub-components (1 representing the best performing region). For difficult to access training areas, percentages refer to the proportion of trainees within the deanery reporting difficulty accessing training in each area. Regional response rates are an estimate using survey responses compared with available trainee numbers in each region. Best and worst hospitals in each region are based on trainee hospital satisfaction scores (maximum 10) and limited to hospitals with at least 2 trainees reporting satisfaction scores.
